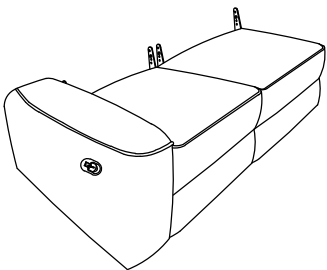
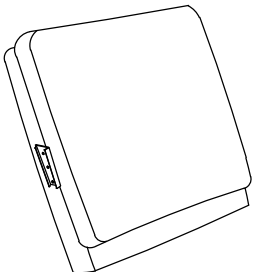
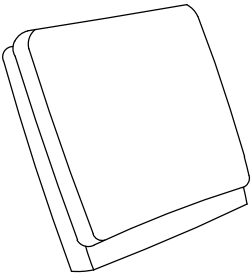
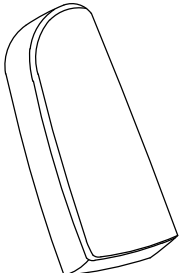
(1/2)Left Side Reclining Love Seat With

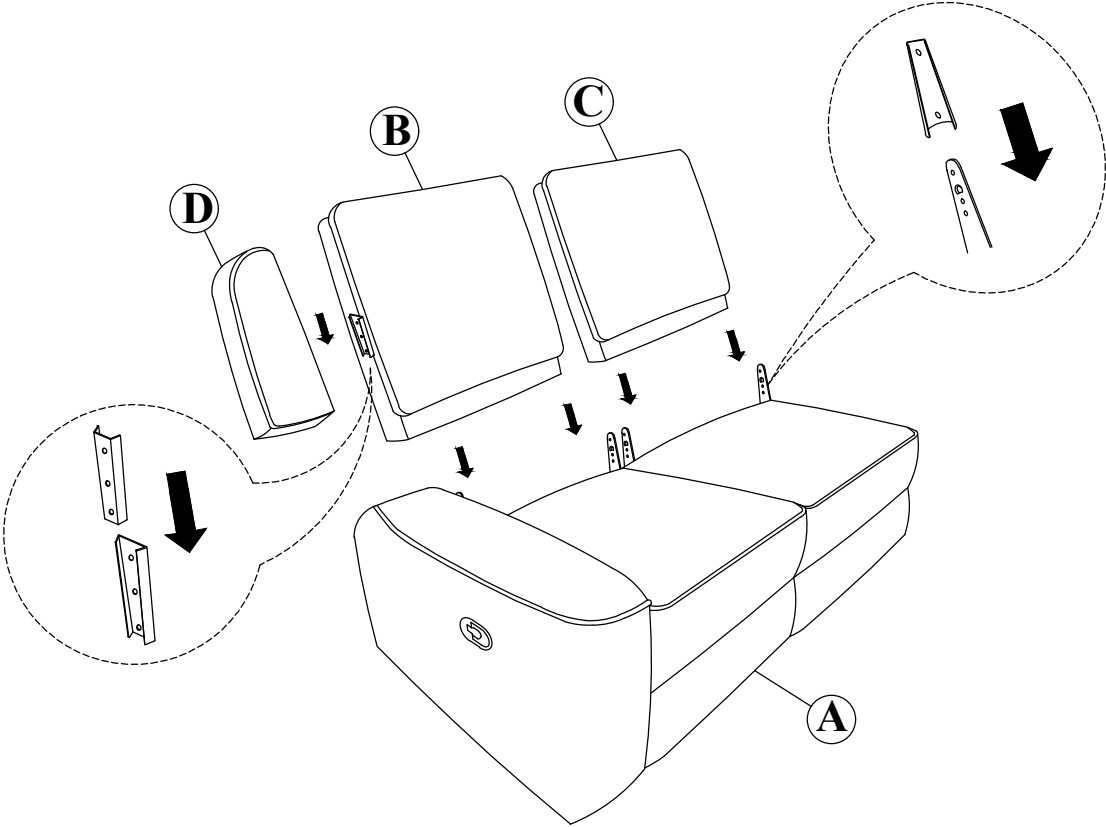
Hardware are stored at the bottom of sofa, please take out for assembly.

Note: Do not use power tools for assembly. Power tools increase the risk of over tightening which lead to splitting or cracking the wood.

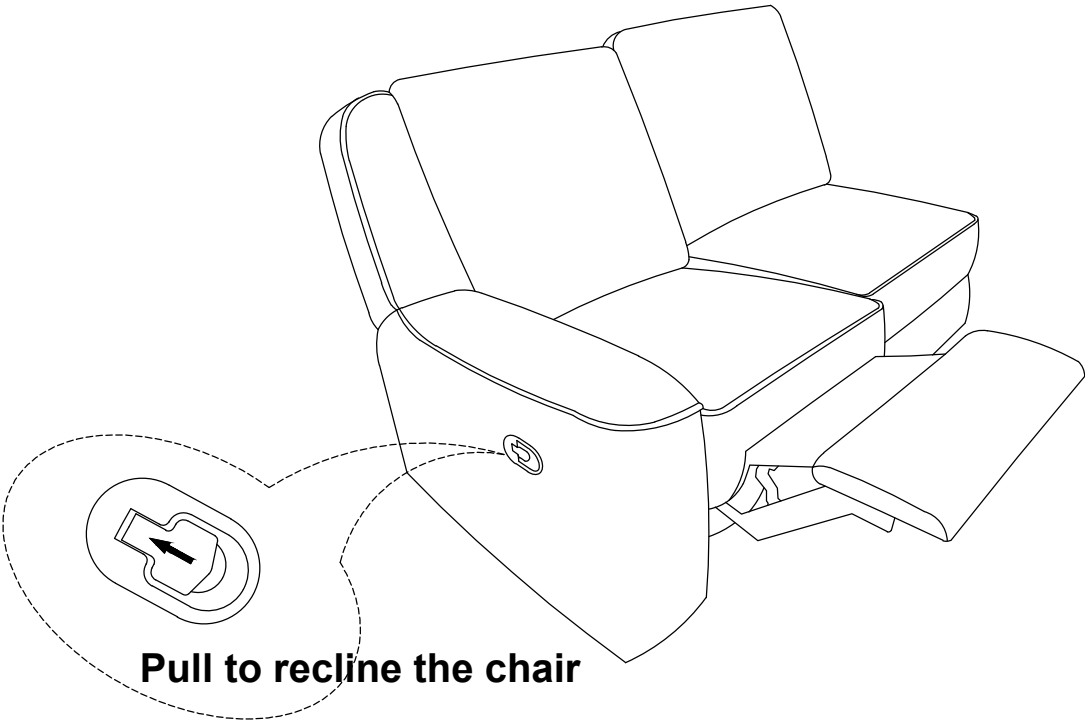

(2/2)Right Side Reclining Chaise



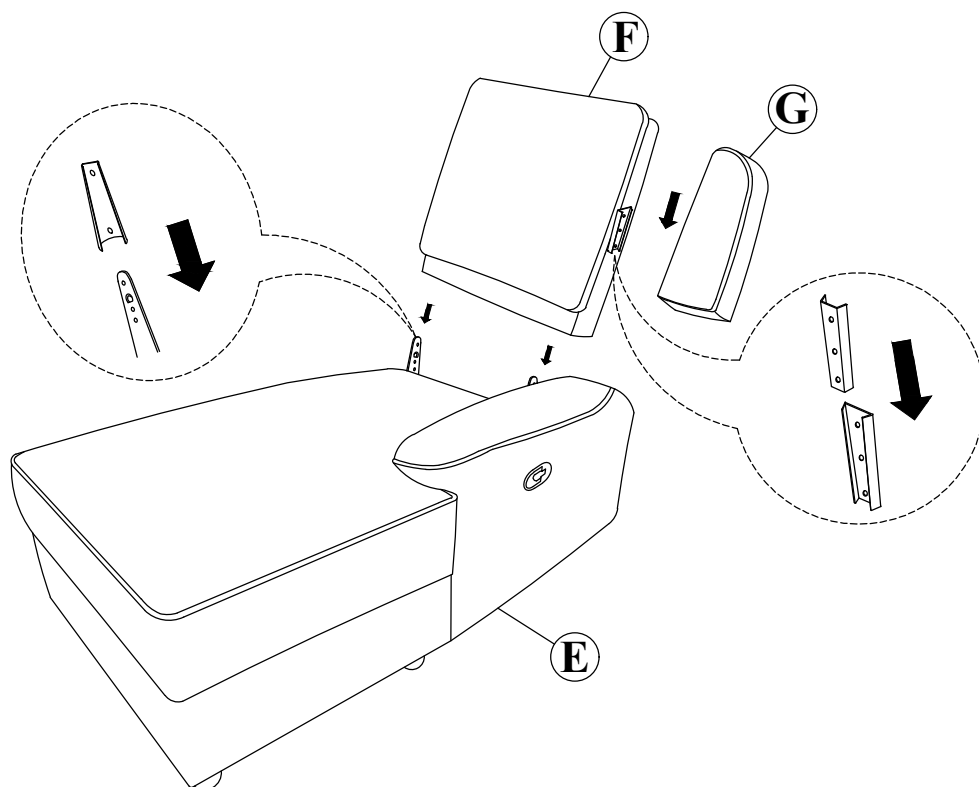
Ears and Back rest are stored at the bottom of seat, please take out for assembly.

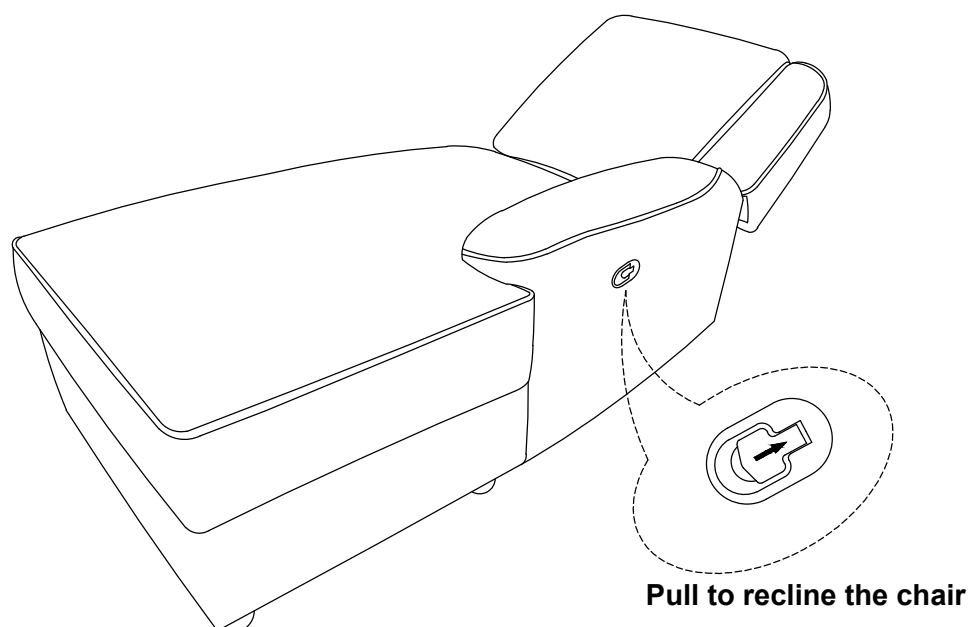

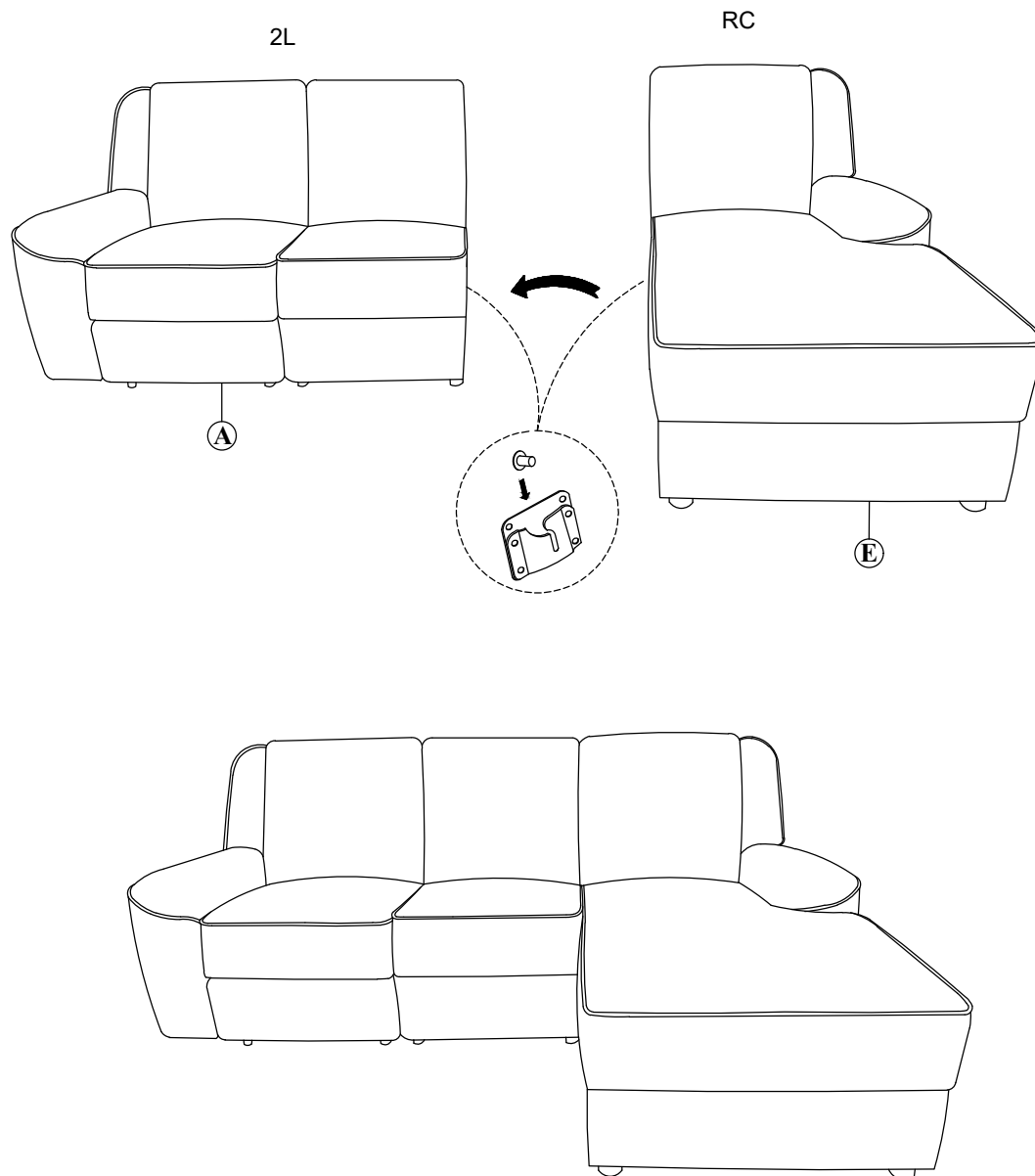
